



Anton Saveliev is an Advisor at Analytical Center for the Government of the Russian Federation and assistant to Prof. Vladimir Lepskiy at the Institute of Philosophy of Russian Academy of Sciences. He is a member of WOSC 2020 Organizational Committee.

His **Research interests** are philosophy of science, organizational cybernetics, self-developing reflexive-active environments, subject-oriented approach to innovation, systems thinking and reflexive processes.
