



Christian Pristipino is an interventional cardiologist in Rome since 1998. He is seating in the board of the European Society of Systems Medicine (EASYM since 2018. He has been the Founding President of the Italian Association for Systems Medicine and Healthcare (ASSIMSS) from 2014 to 2017 and he is the chairman of several official consensus and position papers from scientific cardiologic societies at the national and European level. He is also the co-editor of a book on systems approaches in ischemic heart disease entitled: "Psychotherapy for ischemic heart disease. An evidence-based clinical approach". He authored or co-authored more than 80 papers in peer-reviewed journals with a total impact factor of over 510 and an H index 21.
