



Tatiana A. Medvedeva is a Professor in the Department of World Economy and Law at Siberian State University of Transport, Novosibirsk, Russia. She is a member of the International Society for the Systems Sciences.

Her **professional background** include development in the field of economics. She received a diploma in economic cybernetics from Novosibirsk State University, a kandidatskaya degree (Ph.D) and a doctorate degree (Dc.Sc) in economics from Moscow State University.

In **her professional work**, she has experience in educating and consulting with managers of Russian enterprises for work in the new social and economic conditions. At her university, she is a former Director of the Scientific and Practical Center for Business and Management. She has also worked as Vice-director of the Institute for Prospective Transport Technologies. She was a Visiting Professor at Georgetown University and at The George Washington University in Washington, DC.

Her **area of research** include social and economic cybernetics; philosophy, economics and management of change, particularly the changes in values, beliefs, and institutions now occurring in post-communist countries; interactive planning methods; cross-cultural studies; labor relations.
