



Michael Lissack is a Professor of Design and Innovation at Tongji University (Shanghai) and was the first Walter J. Hickel, Professor at Alaska Pacific University. He is the past president of the American Society for Cybernetics. For 20 years Dr. Lissack was the executive director of the Institute for the Study of Coherence and Emergence (ISCE).

Dr. Lissack founded both a **non-profit research institute** and a charity for artists, launched an international PhD program in corporate anthropology, has written half dozen books, been a successful Wall Street banker, and a candidate for public office. He has taught at a number of academic institutions in the US and Europe, run sixteen international conferences on the topics of explanation, complexity, management, health care, entanglement and ethics and founded a successful academic journal (E:CO).

Worth Magazine recognized Dr. Lissack as one of “**Wall Street’s 25 Smartest Players**” in 1999 and as one of the 100 Americans who have most influenced “how we think about money” in 2001.
